Difference between wheel-clamps for one arm drive and assistans brake

To be able to tell the difference between the wheel-clamps when they are lying on the shelf we have made this info sheet. To the <u>assistans brake</u> and the <u>one arm drive</u> you use the <u>old standard rear axle</u> and for the rear axle you use different wheel-clamps depending on which one of those you mount on the wheelchair. For the assistans brake you use inner wheel-clamp with **art.no**. **3300010** and outer with **art.no**. **3300004**. For the one arm drive you use wheel-clamp with **art.no**. **3300014** and outer with **art.no**. **3300015**. The easiest way to tell what wheel-camp you have is to use a slide calliper and measure the lower holes diameter (see red mark at CAD-image)
